Kuwait backs steps against sabotage acts

KUWAIT yesterday repeated its support for the measures taken by Bahrain during the recent acts of rioting and sabotage.

Visiting Kuwaiti Labour and Social Affairs Minister Ahmed Khalid Al Kulaib said that any harm to Bahrain was a harm to Kuwait.

He added that such a policy had been confirmed by both the Amir of Kuwait Shaikh Jaber Al Ahmed Al Jaber Al Sabah and Crown Prince and Prime Minister Shaikh Saad Al Abdulla Al Salem Al Sabah.

Mr Al Kulaib said these events were alien to the region and its customs and traditions.

He said they should be confronted with the utmost firmness in order to protect the region's stride, gains, security and stability.

The Kuwaiti minister expressed the condemnation of the government of Kuwait and its people for such acts of sabotage.

Mr Al Kulaib arrived in Bahrain yesterday on a three-day visit at the invitation of Labour and Social Affairs Minister Abdulnabi Al Sho'ala.
